



Fire Season Extends from April 1- October 31

Daytime burning requires a permit

Open Burning (without a permit) is allowed only **if** :-

- ✓ The Fire Hazard Rating is **LOW** or **MODERATE**
- ✓ The fire is tended by a responsible person who has adequate tools or water to contain the fire
- ✓ The fire is ignited 2 hours before sunset or later
- ✓ And is extinguished 2 hours after sunrise or earlier
- ✓ The pile is less than 2 meters by 2 meters
- ✓ The fire is at least 2 meters away from flammable materials

During **HIGH** Fire Hazard Rating, No Open Burning is allowed, including Incinerators. Camp fires are allowed for Cooking and Warmth only. Flame size can be no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet

During **EXTREME** Fire Rating, **NO BURNING IS ALLOWED**

Incinerators are required to have a mesh cover to eliminate sparks
